DAY 1

SCRIPTURE

“He who commits adultery lacks sense; he who does it destroys himself.” — Proverbs 6:32

REFLECTION

Infidelity doesn't just break hearts—it detonates legacy. The rubble left behind isn't just emotional; it's spiritual. Today, we name the wreckage. Not to wallow, but to begin rebuilding. God doesn't avoid ruins—He resurrects from them.

PRAYER

The War Within

DAY 2

SCRIPTURE

“So flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace...” — 2 Timothy 2:22

REFLECTION

Infidelity isn't just about lust—it's about escape. From pain, boredom, inadequacy. But the war isn't out there—it's in here. Today, we stop running and start fighting.

PRAYER

God, I've been a coward. I've fled instead of fought. Give me the guts to face my emptiness and the grace to fill it with You.

ACTION STEP

Fast from digital distractions today. No social media, no entertainment. Sit in silence. Let the war surface.



Brick by Brick

DAY 3

SCRIPTURE

“Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.” — Psalm 51:10

REFLECTION

Rebuilding starts with repentance. Not just saying sorry—but surrendering the blueprint. You don’t need behavior modification. You need heart renovation.

PRAYER

Lord, tear down the false walls I’ve built. Cleanse me. Rewire me. I want a heart that beats for You—not for escape.

ACTION STEP

Write a letter of confession to God. Be brutally honest. Burn it afterward as a symbol of surrender.



Sever the Secret

DAY 4

SCRIPTURE

“Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead expose them.” – Ephesians 5:11

REFLECTION

Infidelity thrives in secrecy. Today, we drag it into the light. Exposure isn't weakness—it's warfare. The enemy loses power when the truth is spoken.

PRAYER

Jesus, give me courage to confess. Not just to You, but to those I've deceived. Let truth be the beginning of healing.

ACTION STEP

Tell one trusted brother about your struggle. No filters. No spin. Just truth.



Guard the Gates

DAY 5

SCRIPTURE

“Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.” — Proverbs 4:23

REFLECTION

Infidelity doesn't start in the bedroom—it starts in the mind. In the scroll. In the glance. Today, we fortify the gates. Not out of fear, but out of honor.

PRAYER

God, help me guard what You've entrusted. Make me vigilant. Make me holy. Make me dangerous to the enemy.

ACTION STEP

Audit your phone. Delete any app, contact, or content that opens the gate to temptation.



Rekindle the Covenant

DAY 6

SCRIPTURE

“Let marriage be held in honor among all...” — Hebrews 13:4a

REFLECTION

Infidelity desecrates covenants. But God restores what we dishonor. Today, we remember the vow—not just to a spouse, but to God. Covenant isn’t a contract—it’s a calling.

PRAYER

Lord, restore the fire of my covenant. Teach me to honor what I’ve broken. Make me a man of vow, not just apology.

ACTION STEP

Write down 3 ways you can tangibly honor your spouse this week. Then do them—without expecting anything in return.



Resurrection Ground

DAY 7

SCRIPTURE

“Behold, I will cause breath to enter you, and you shall live.” — Ezekiel 37:5

REFLECTION

Dry bones don't stay dry when God speaks. Infidelity may have buried you—but resurrection is your birthright. Today, we rise. Not perfect. But alive.

PRAYER

Breathe into me, God. I'm done with death. Raise me up—not just for me, but for every man who needs proof that resurrection is real.

ACTION STEP

Record a voice memo to yourself declaring who you are in Christ. Play it back when shame tries to speak louder.
