

# Servant Leadership

## DAY 1

### SCRIPTURE

“For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.” - Mark 10:45

### REFLECTION

True leadership in the home flows from a servant’s heart. Christ laid down His rights to serve us. When you wash your family’s feet—through listening, helping, and prioritizing their needs—you mirror the King who serve

### PRAYER

Father, cultivate a servant’s heart in me. Show me how to lay down my rights and serve my wife and children with humility and grace.

### ACTION STEP

Identify one household task you normally delegate or avoid. Complete it today with a joyful heart as an act of service to your family.



# Loving Sacrifice

## DAY 2

---

### **SCRIPTURE**

“Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her.” - Ephesians 5:25

### **REFLECTION**

Leadership in marriage demands sacrificial love, not mere emotion or convenience. Christ’s love is costly, intentional, and unwavering. Your wife needs more than words—she needs a husband who lays down his life in daily sacrifices and big decisions.

### **PRAYER**

Lord Jesus, teach me to love my wife with Your sacrificial love. Help me lay down my comfort and desires for her flourishing and joy.

### **ACTION STEP**

Ask your wife about an unmet need—emotional, physical, or spiritual—and take a concrete step today to meet it without being prompted.



# Spiritual Headship

## DAY 3

### SCRIPTURE

“Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.” - Ephesians 6:4

### REFLECTION

Leading spiritually means nurturing your children’s faith without harshness or neglect. Balance firmness and grace—discipline anchored in Scripture and instruction steeped in love. Your consistent, gentle guidance forms their spiritual foundation.

### PRAYER

Heavenly Father, grant me wisdom to spiritually lead my children. Keep me patient in correction and faithful in teaching them Your ways.

### ACTION STEP

Schedule a family devotion time this week. Choose a simple Bible story or verse, and guide your children through discussion and prayer.



# Wisdom in Discipline

## DAY 4

### SCRIPTURE

“Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it.” - Proverbs 22:6

### REFLECTION

Discipline is life coaching rooted in wisdom. When you correct out of love and consistency, you build character rather than rebellion. A father’s wise guidance helps children internalize values that last a lifetime.

### PRAYER

Father, infuse me with Your wisdom in every disciplinary choice. Help me correct with love, clarity, and consistency.

### ACTION STEP

Reflect on a recent disciplinary moment. Identify one way to apply grace next time—whether by explaining the “why” or ending with a time of prayer.



# Integrity and Example

## DAY 5

### SCRIPTURE

“Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ.” -

1 Corinthians 11:1

### REFLECTION

Your family watches your every move. Authentic leadership begins with personal integrity—aligning your words, actions, and faith. When your children see you live out what you preach, your influence deepens and your leadership gains credibility.

### PRAYER

Lord, expose any area where my walk doesn't match my talk. Grant me integrity so my family can trust and follow me with confidence.

### ACTION STEP

Choose one area of inconsistency—speech, work ethic, or devotion—and take a tangible step today to align your practice with your convictions.



# Building Unity

## DAY 6

---

### **SCRIPTURE**

“And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.” -

Colossians 3:14

### **REFLECTION**

Unity in the home is the fruit of sacrificial love. When you prioritize love—patient, kind, and forgiving—you weave your family together. A leader fosters harmony by seeking reconciliation, encouraging open communication, and modeling Christ-like empathy.

### **PRAYER**

Jesus, teach me to love my family well. Help me bind our hearts together with Your love and mend any divisions with grace.

### **ACTION STEP**

Plan a simple family activity (meal, game night, walk) focused on connection. Lead the time with open questions and attentive listening.



# Legacy of Faithfulness

## DAY 7

### SCRIPTURE

“A good man leaves an inheritance to his children’s children, but the sinner’s wealth is laid up for the righteous.” - Proverbs 13:22

### REFLECTION

Your leadership shapes today and generations to come. By faithfully stewarding your time, resources, and spiritual influence, you invest in an inheritance that invites future generations to know the Lord.

### PRAYER

Heavenly Father, help me lead with eternity in view. Let my actions today plant seeds of faith that flourish in my children’s children.

### ACTION STEP

Write a brief note or record a short message for each child, naming one spiritual truth you pray they will carry into the next generation. Share it now or save it for a future moment.
